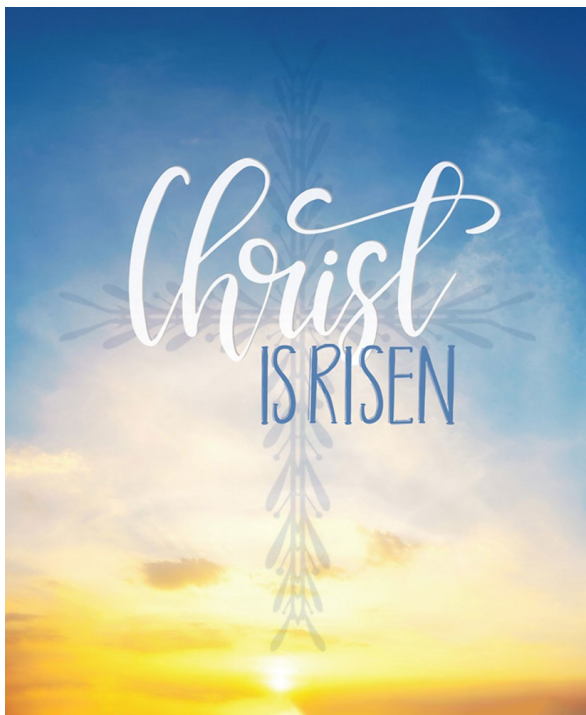

*Living and Sharing God's Love*

*For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.* — Romans 6:5

Recently my son, Aiden, asked if he could practice basketball in the Family Life Center (FLC) while I finished up some evening work around the church. Normally this wouldn't have been a problem, but this evening we had a family from *Family Promise* staying at Bethany. Most of you know that *Family Promise* is an organization that assists homeless families by asking local churches to host them in their facilities for a week at a time. During the day, *Family Promise* works with the parents to find permanent solutions to the families' problems, while the children are usually in school. Then in the evening, local churches provide meals, a safe place to sleep, and show the families good Christian hospitality. So I told Aiden he could play basketball in the FLC as long as it didn't interfere with what was going on with *Family Promise*.

After about an hour I had finished what I needed to do and was ready to go home. So I walked into the FLC to get Aiden, drained a couple of threes from way downtown, and told him it was time to go. At the same time one of the children from *Family Promise* whom we were hosting that night was in the kitchen having a snack before bedtime. When he saw us leaving, he said goodbye and, "I love Family Promise. There's always food to eat!"

Getting into the car, Aiden asked me what this child meant. I was somewhat surprised by this question, as he is old enough to know that there are people who are homeless and who don't have enough food to eat. But I think that to put a face on, or meet, a real person who is struggling with overwhelming and abstract problems like homelessness or hunger, was an eye-opener for him. And truth be told, in many ways it was for me as well.

The other day I challenged some of the staff at Bethany, asking them why the resurrection of Jesus is important. We then discussed how it proved that Jesus' teachings of forgiveness are true and that He

is the Son of God. Someone also said that having been united with Christ in Baptism, we too shall enjoy the resurrection when Christ returns. These are all good biblical answers and certainly true. But in addition to them, I also believe that there is a link between Jesus' resurrection and that child having a snack in Bethany's kitchen.

You see, I am convinced that God did not put our congregation in Cedar Rapids during this day and age to feed the hungry and provide shelter for the homeless. The Church, as it always has, exists to proclaim the Word of God and administer the sacraments. So why then do we help *Family Promise*? Why do we make sure that at least one kid has a place to sleep and a bedtime snack, if only for a week? We do these things and many, many others around Bethany because of the resurrection!

Because Jesus has risen from the grave, we know our sins are forgiven and we will enjoy eternal life with Christ. This now frees us to live as His people who have been saved from our sin. There is no need to worry about what will happen to us in the future or when we die, for Christ has already been into the grave and has come out victoriously. Through our faith and trust in Him, He now gives us this same victory and this changes everything in the lives of believers. It enables us to live outside of ourselves and help others who are in need.

Scripture does not tell us that Christ rose from the grave so that a child could have snack before he goes to bed. But I'm fairly certain that if the tomb wasn't empty, someone would have been going to bed hungry the other night. That young child reminded me, and I hope all of you, that when I look at what Bethany does with *Family Promise* and the many other wonderful things we do as a congregation, as well as individual or small groups of Christians, what we are seeing is God's redeemed people living out their Easter hope. We are seeing people who know that Christ is risen, and that we will rise too! By God's grace, may this always be so here at Bethany and in your own life with Jesus!

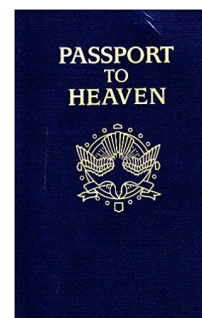

## Family Promise

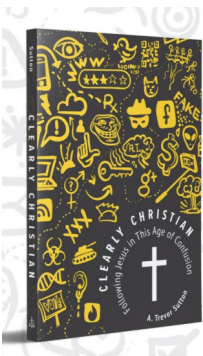
The mission of Family Promise is to **help homeless and low-income families achieve sustainable independence through compassionate care, hospitality, and professional support.**

If you are in the nursery with children, gather the children and proceed down the stairs to meet up with parent(s) near the drinking fountain outside the boys restroom in the lower level.

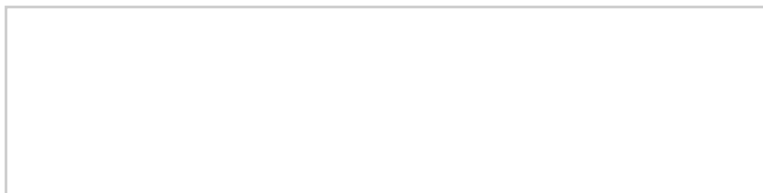
