

Bethany Living and Sharing God's Love

Whenever I meet someone for the first time it seems that one of the questions I am always asked is some version of, "What do you do for a living?" When I tell them I'm the pastor of the best church in world, Bethany Lutheran, they usually reply, "Where is that?" And it is that question that always makes me a little sad, because I have always envisioned Bethany to be the type of church that everyone, believer and unbeliever alike, knows where it's at. But when I'm asked, "Where is that?" I'll ask if they know where Washington High School is and that we're right across the street.

Ever since I described Bethany's location to someone like that many years ago, I have always wanted Bethany to be known for something other than, "Across the street from Washington High School." Nothing scandalous or bad of course, nor something that is just "cool" or "popular" like, "We're the church that has fireworks every Sunday night!" But I have always wanted Bethany to be known for being the church that does what churches should be doing. Something like helping the poor, like we do with Family Promise. Or having great educational opportunities like Milestones, Sunday School, or our Men's Bible Study, or the group that meets at Mr. Beans. Someone once told me that we should be doing more to let people know about all of the wonderful music that we have at Bethany, that we should be doing more to highlight the talents of Luke, Carolyn, Gerard and all of the other wonderful musicians and singers who serve with them, so we could be known for our music. And for a long time I agreed with this, that is until recently.

Now don't get me wrong. I wish the whole world could hear the music at Bethany and I wouldn't be surprised if when I'm in heaven I'll hear Luke, Carolyn, and Gerard leading the "angels, archangels, and all the company of heaven"! Also, we must continue doing things like caring for those who are in need and proclaiming and teaching the Word of God. But recently I realized that as wonderful as all of those things are, that's not what I

want Bethany to be known for by themselves. Instead, when I tell people I'm the pastor of the greatest church in the world, Bethany Lutheran, I want them to respond, "Oh, that's where people meet Jesus Christ!"

Out of all the things people and our world needs today, meeting and knowing Jesus Christ as one's Lord and Savior are at the top of the list. And the Bible and our Lutheran Confessions (The Book of Concord) tell us that people meet Jesus Christ through His Word and Sacraments. It may not be the most "exciting" or popular way for people to encounter Christ, but that is how Jesus Himself tells us He does it in His own Word. When people are baptized they encounter Christ. When people come to Holy Communion, they eat and drink the body and blood of Christ for the forgiveness of their sin and the strengthening of their faith. Jesus is also with people when they read, study and learn the Word of God. To reject the ways that God tells us He comes to us is to ultimately reject Him and create a god in our own image or likeness - a god that behaves how we think he should, and not how God actually does.

I hope that people know about Adult VBS or Everyone His Witness or all the other wonderful ministries and programs that Bethany does and offers. But these things must ultimately point people to Christ as their Lord and Savior. To do otherwise is only to help them so far. But being a church of God's Word and His sacraments will ensure that no matter what we do as we live and share God's love, people will not only receive God's grace and mercy into eternity, but that they will also meet their Savior at Bethany and in heaven.



#### Evangelism Training: July 31 | August 7 | August 14

Every One His Witness is a program that seeks to motivate believers to be active witnesses of the Gospel in their communities. This evangelism program, through real-world context and practical application, equips Lutherans to share the Good News with those they meet who are of differing religions and world-views. The core module of the program provides participants with a strong foundation of witnessing, delivered through a combination of video instruction, individual exercises, group discussion, and partnered activities.

#### First Aid / CPR / AED Training

Training will be offered at Bethany on Saturday, August 24, 8:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. CPR stands for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, a combination of rescue breathing (mouth-to-mouth resuscitation) and chest compressions. If a person isn't breathing or circulating blood adequately, CPR can restore circulation of oxygen-rich blood to the brain.

AED stands for automated external defibrillator. This is a portable device that checks the heart rhythm and can send an electric shock to the heart to try to restore a normal rhythm. AEDs are used to treat sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). SCA is a condition in which the heart suddenly and unexpectedly stops beating.

CPR can save a life by restoring breathing and circulation until advanced life support can be given by emergency medical care providers. Your cost for training would be \$10; Bethany's Human Care Board covers the remaining costs. The course is provided by the American Heart Association. **Contact Nurse Ronda at nurse.bethanycr@gmail.com or 364-6026 to sign up** for this training.


