Bethany Living and Sharing God's Love

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God...who for us men and for our salvation came down from beaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man — The Nicene Creed

I have always found it interesting that Christian artists seem to have a habit of portraying Jesus in ways that resemble themselves, often giving Him the physical features of their own ethnicity. In paintings from around the world, Jesus will often look very different depending upon if the artist is from Europe, Africa, Asia, or the Americas.

When I first noticed this tendency in Christian art, it somewhat annoyed me. While we know from the Scriptures that Jesus' father is God, His mother was a young Jewish girl from first century Israel. Therefore, Jesus probably looked like your typical Middle Eastern man from that time and place (Isaiah 53:2). And I thought that portraying our Savior in whatever way fits our cultural and ethnic expectations denigrates the very real, historical acts of His saving work to the realm of mythology or fables.

But then I thought of something this Advent season when I was looking at the Nicene Creed. When talking of Jesus, we confess in the Creed that Jesus was incarnate by the Holy Spirit and "made man". Notice that the Creed, at least in our English translation, does not say that Jesus was made "a" man, but rather just "man". Speaking of Jesus' taking on our humanity in this way helps all people identify themselves with Jesus. And this is indeed what He would have us do. For Jesus is the embodiment of all humanity into one person. Where we have all failed to keep God's Law and live up to His expectations, Jesus has kept the Law and met those expectations perfectly for every person. This was so that He could die and rise again to be the Savior of, not just this or that group of people, but of every human being, regardless of where they come from or what they look like. So, from now on when I look at a picture of Jesus that doesn't look like a Middle-Eastern Jew, I won't be so troubled. Rather, I'll appreciate that the artist, whether consciously or not, is recognizing that Jesus took upon Himself their human nature to their Savior.

This is something for all of us at Bethany to remember as we move together into the new year of 2020 A.D. The mission of our congregation is to *Live and Share God's Love*. Looking back, we give thanks to God for all the ways that we have been able to do in years past. And looking forward we can be confident that God will continue to bless and be with us as we do His work in the future. But we must also remember, that as Jesus was "made man" to be every person's Savior, we must live and share this love of Christ with everyone for whom He has died.

I mention this because I have always believed that the makeup of a healthy congregation, (whether we are talking age, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, or other factors), should always reflect the community in which it is located. But this is not necessarily the case at Bethany, especially when it comes ethnic diversity. While I believe that this is not intentional, talking about why this is and addressing any issues that might be contributing to it – must be. That is why I would like to see everyone at Bethany come to the Embracing Diversity workshop on January 18. There, I'll be looking forward to discussing any obstacles that we may unintentionally be placing in people's way that prevent us from Living and Sharing God's Love with everyone in our community. And the more people we have in attendance, the more productive our workshop will be, and the better job we'll do in accomplishing our mission together.

More information on the Embracing Diversity Workshop, as well as other happenings at Bethany, can be found inside this issue of the *Beacon*. As you read through it this month I pray that you'll give thanks for what the Lord is doing in our congregation and be excited to continue to *Live and Share* the love of God who was "made man" for all people.


Baby Bottle Boomerang
