

Pilate's command to the crowd at Jesus' crucifixion speaks an incredible truth—Jesus was indeed man. More specifically, He was God and man, an eternal being inhabiting a human body. Jesus had a body. He hungered, prayed, and bled. He had a mother, He drank wine, He was baptized. This Lenten season, behold the man—the man who suffered, died, and rose again. The man who lived a perfect life and defeated death. The man whose death led to your life.



Bethany Living and Sharing God's Love

Recently I was reading of a man who was unhappy with his job and life in general. A graduate of Harvard Business School, he made \$1.2 million a year. He recognized that his education and wealth gave him extraordinary privilege in our society but was dissatisfied with his situation in life. He said, "I feel like I'm wasting my life...My work feels totally meaningless...If you spend 12 hours a day doing work you hate, at some point it doesn't matter what the paycheck is." Having spent 10 years in northeast Pennsylvania with its history of anthracite coal mining, it was initially hard for me to feel too sympathetic for this man. But as I continued reading, he mentioned that he recently received a job offer at a start-up that he would have loved to take. The only "problem" was that it offered only half of his current pay. He said that his wife laughed at him when he told her about the offer because this new dream job would not have allowed them to continue their current lifestyle. So now he felt that he was trapped. What a cruel twist in life for this miserable worker! The very things that he had worked so hard for, were now the same things that were keeping him in a life that he wasn't enjoying.

At this point we might be tempted to tell ourselves the moral of the story is simple – don't become overly attached to material possessions or a certain "lifestyle" we want to live. More importantly, we might tell ourselves to find meaning and purpose in our lives, whether it be where we work or in the other vocations of family, friends, and community that we all share. But if this is the case, the age-old question arises, "How do we do that?" How can we find meaning and purpose so that we will not be trapped in a life that we don't want to live?

As you'll see in this edition of the *Beacon*, March 6 is Ash Wednesday and marks the beginning of the season of Lent. During this 40-day church season leading up to Easter, Christians pay special attention to the suffering and death of our Savior, Jesus Christ. In doing so, we may increase our devotional lives by praying, reading Scripture, or maybe even "fasting" in one way or another. But we are also to gain a greater appreciation for

exactly what it is that God has done for us through Christ. It is easy to say that Christ has died for my sins. But it is quite another thing to comprehend our sinfulness and the awesome price that Jesus paid on the cross to forgive it. That type of focus on our sin and Christ's gift of forgiveness is what Lent brings into our lives each year. And maybe it can help us find meaning and purpose in them as well.

As we ponder the suffering and death of Jesus during Lent, we are reminded of why He did this. In Mark 10:45 Jesus says, "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Everything that Jesus went through in His ministry was not done for His own sake, but for ours. The purpose of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection was to serve, not Himself, but others! And if our Lord, the King of all Creation, found purpose in serving others, might we too be able to do the same?

It would seem so. Two professors from Yale and the University of Michigan wanted to know why some janitors in a hospital were happier with their jobs than others. They interviewed a satisfied worker who mopped rooms in a brain-injury unit where many of the patients were comatose. In addition to her normal duties, she said that she would also take the time to rearrange the pictures on the walls and tell patients jokes. This wasn't her job, per se, but it was a way that she believed she could serve others while doing her job.

As we begin another Lenten season together, I pray that we will always remember what Jesus has done so that we might have forgiveness and eternal life. But this year, let also remember that Jesus did this as a servant and for our benefit. Knowing and trusting that Christ did these things for us, may we be encouraged and strengthened not only to love God, but also to serve one another with the same type of sacrificial love He has given us. And if we do so, I'm confident we'll understand our purpose and the meaning of our lives.


### DCE Intern Update

# Sewing Quilts for Lutheran World Relief




