

Participate in a Focus Group

Thank you to everyone who participated in the congregational survey this year. Results from the "Holy Cow!" Church Assessment Tool were presented to the congregation at a meeting on August 21. We are now continuing the work that was started with the surveys by asking members of Bethany to participate in a focus group. There will be two focus group opportunities in September:

Saturday, September 10 at 9:00 - 10:30 a.m. Monday, September 12 at 7:00 - 8:30 p.m.

Below are some of the questions that may be discussed during the focus group. Please take some time to review and prayerfully consider how you might respond.

- 1. What are the key areas, ministries, or aspects of Bethany that are working well?
- 2. What is Bethany known for in the community?
- 3. If your vision for Bethany became a reality, describe what we would be like in 3-5 years.
- 4. What changes or improvements would you recommend to accomplish your vision?
- 5. What are some things we do today that aren't working? Could be in any area including worship, facilities, ministries, and more.
- 6. What activities or ministries would get you excited enough to get more involved in the Church than you are today?
- 7. How could Bethany better reach new people and incorporate them into the life of the Church?
- 8. Martin Luther said, "Next to the Word of God, music deserves the highest praise." With that in mind, what ideas do you have to make our music program even better?
- 9. If you have attended or visited other churches, what did you like about their services, buildings, or ministries?

The church is the assembly of saints in which the gospel is taught purely and the sacraments are administered rightly.

- Article VII of the Augsburg Confession

The Lutheran reformers who wrote and subscribed to the Augsburg Confession knew what the Scriptures teach the church is and what it does. Today, the assembled saints at Bethany continue to confess that the church is where the gospel is taught purely and the sacraments are administered rightly and therefore this is what the church does. But what does that look like here and now? How do we teach the gospel today in the age of social media? How do we administer the sacraments according to the Lord's instructions in an ever-increasing pluralistic society? While we may be tempted to say that the church must not be changed by the culture around us, the fact of the matter is that the church does and must.

It is true, the essence of the church (Word and Sacrament) does not change, but those things around them do. For instance, Martin Luther wrote his German Mass and translated the Bible into German so that the average person attending church could understand what was being said and could have access to God's Word themselves. Likewise, last century our own LC-MS moved from having most of its services in German to having English services. While the Gospel was still proclaimed and the sacraments administered in all of these circumstances, the way (specifically the language used) had to change for the church to accomplish its mission.

Over the last week, I have been extremely blessed to have so many people at Bethany help me celebrate my 10-year anniversary serving as our congregation's pastor. Reflecting on those 10 years, it has been wonderful and humbling to remember the creative and various ways that the Holy Spirit has used all of us, and many who are no longer with us, to share God's love through Jesus Christ with one another, our community, and the world. But, as we continue to celebrate and give thanks to God for what He has done over the last several years, we

must recognize that our community, the world, and even ourselves have changed over the years. Therefore, we must continue examine and evaluate the things we are doing; plan for the future; and pray for God's guidance.

In order to do all of this together, Bethany's leadership is asking all of our members who were eligible to take the Church Assessment Tool (CAT) earlier this year (members who are 16 or older), to participate in one of two focus groups coming up on September 10 or 12. During these focus groups, everyone will have an opportunity to share their specific vision for Bethany and ideas on how we can effectively do Word and Sacrament ministry today. A series of questions that will be used can be found on the cover of the this month's Beacon to help people begin thinking about their vision for Bethany. I would ask that everyone prayerfully consider participating in a focus group, as the more people involved, the clearer we may discern God will for us.

Once again, I would like to thank everyone who helped me celebrate my 10th anniversary here at Bethany. The party, cards, gifts, and prayers have been over whelming in helping me celebrate something that has truly been an honor to do with all you. But as wonderful as these last 10 years have been, I look forward to many more years of Word and Sacrament ministry among and with you all. And like you, I'm excited to see what this will look like and what God has in store as we *Live and Share* His love together.


Women's Group
