Lent at Bethany – The Lenten season, beginning this Wednesday with Ash Wednesday, is a somber 40-day season before Easter when Christians pay special attention to their sinfulness and Christ's suffering and death. As such, it can serve as a time of spiritual renewal, as many Christians increase their spiritual disciplines (prayer, devotions in God's Word, etc....). To help with this, Bethany will continue our tradition of Midweek services at 7pm every Wednesday in Lent, beginning on Ash Wednesday. The theme for our Midweek services this year is *You Meant It For Evil, But God Meant It For Good*. During our Ash Wednesday service, and on that day between 7am and 8am, everyone may participate in the ancient Christian rite of the Imposition of Ashes (applying ashes to our heads or hands as a sign of our repentance.) We pray that everyone will take advantage of opportunities to grow in their faith.

Bethany LWML invites everyone in the congregation to support our food pantry by donating ingredients to make a casserole. These ingredients will be wrapped in a foil casserole pan, along with the recipe and distributed at the food pantry March 19th. Sign up sheets are next to the shopping cart.
