Pastor's Page

So, first of all, let me assert my firm belief that the only thing we have to fear is fear itself—nameless, unreasoning, unjustified terror which paralyzes needed efforts to convert retreat into advance.

– F.D.R. Inaugural Adress, March 4, 1933

On March 7, President Biden gave his State of the Union address to Congress and the American public. This year the response to President Biden's State of the Union address was given by Sen. Katie Britt of Alabama. And it should come as no surprise that Sen. Britt, a Republican, was quite critical of the President and the message that he gave concerning the state of our country.

For instance, concerning the situation at the nation's southern border, Sen. Britt said that when she first took office, she traveled to the Del Rio sector of Texas and spoke to a woman who had been kidnapped when 12 years old and subjected to terrible abuse by drug cartels. She then said, "We wouldn't be OK with this happening in a thirdworld country. This is the United States of America, and it's past time we start acting like it. President Biden's border crisis is a disgrace. It's despicable. And it's almost entirely preventable."

This story was shocking to many people, including myself. While almost everyone agrees the situation at our nation's southern border needs to be addressed, after hearing this story I began to wonder if our President's current policy is a "disgrace" and "despicable." I wondered, how could something like this happen in our country, the greatest on earth? And then, as they say, I heard the "rest of the story."

Sen. Britt had indeed spoken to a woman in Texas who had survived everything she had mentioned in her speech. However, it soon came out that the events she had referenced happened 20 years ago when George W. Bush was president. Also, the events did not happen in Texas, or anywhere else in the United States, but rather in Mexico. This being the case, it is hard to see how this could be an example of President Biden's "disgraceful border crisis," or how he could have prevented it. When asked about all this, Sen. Britt correctly pointed out that she never said when or where the events happened and therefore had done nothing wrong. However, the context and Sen.

Britt's carefully chosen words strongly suggest that she knew she was being misleading. Which led me to ask, "Why?"

Unfortunately, I believe we see the reason "why" all over the place today and it is fear. People have known for a long time that fear can be a powerful motivating factor for both good and bad. And political leaders take advantage of this, using fear to advance their own agendas. In an effort to score political points, I believe that this is what Sen. Britt was doing. And I'm afraid that we will only see more of this in the future, despite President Roosevelt's warning in his Inaugural Address about fear paralyzing progress in our country and in our lives.

But what if there was something to counter the fear of today, regardless of where it comes from? Regardless of whether it is justified or irrational? Based on facts or upon lies? What if there was something that could make us unafraid of whatever is in our future?

In Matthew 28:5-6a we read, "But the angel said to the women, 'Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here, for he has risen..." The Gospels tell us fear was all over the place after Jesus was crucified. But fear was driven out of the lives of everyone who knew Christ had been raised! Knowing Jesus' tomb was empty, no longer did they fear the governing authorities (Acts 5:29), hardships in life (Acts 5:41), and even death itself (I Cor. 15:55).

As all of us face real fears in life and as people will continue to use fear to manipulate others, I pray that our faith in the Risen Lord will drive out that fear today. For Christ has conquered the grave! His victory belongs to us! We need to be faithful and wise as we live our lives today, but we also need not fear fear, nor let it determine how we live. Have a happy, blessed, and a fearless Easter!

Bethany youth will serve breakfast on Easter morning at 9:45-10:45 a.m. A freewill offering will be collected to fund their mission trip to Denver.




Joy's Journal




Blood Drive: May 2


